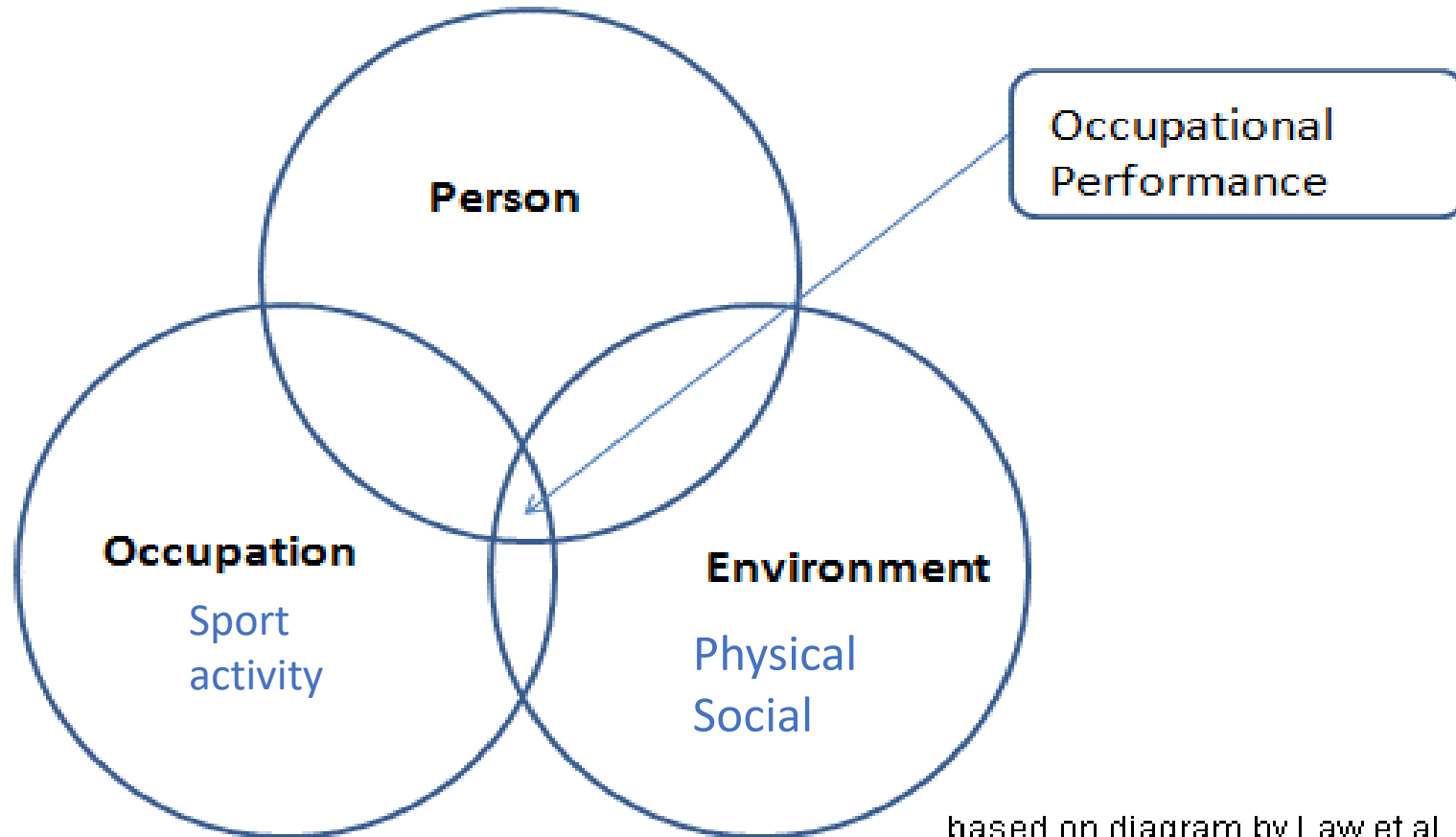

Equity is when every student has what they need to succeed.



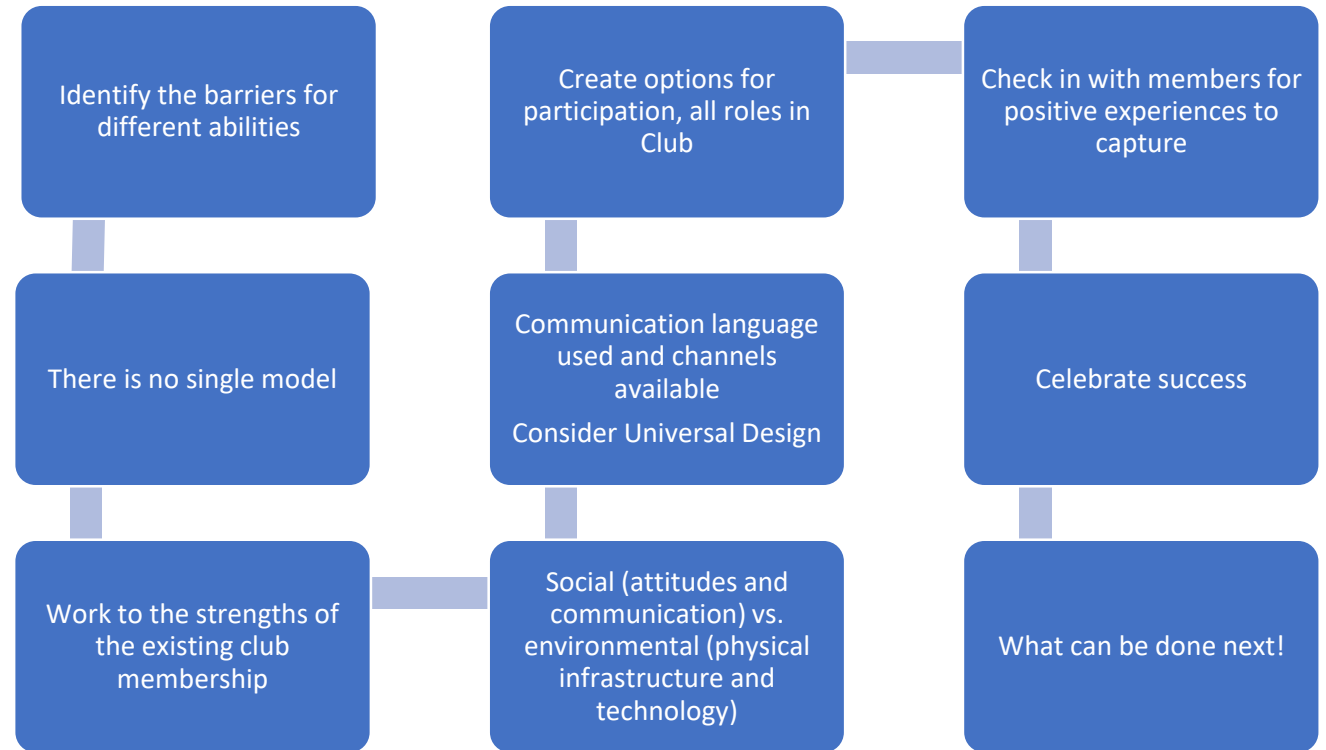
Inclusion vs. other

What do you want to achieve	How will you do it	Who will drive it	When will you do it	How will you know it works
Social story for First Aid kit	Look at other examples i.e. other clubs/sports, St John's First Aid, Mock up a version for your club	Inclusion working group and First Aid Officers	Have it ready for pre-season	Test it out with young people/parents in the club Get feedback from First Aid Officers who use it
Funding for modified equipment	Identify funding streams and process Check if can be used to reimburse or not Who in club has grant writing skills Look for training / information sessions	Inclusion sub committee	Be clear about the timelines for when to submit and when the monies will be available to successful applicants	Successful application Equipment is used by club
Stories on website demonstrating inclusion	Understand inclusive language and symbols Photos of club activities showing inclusion	Welcome Officer Communications Officer	Ongoing	Ask new members for feedback on the website
Have a person on committee with disability	Identify deliverables for committee roles and skills needed to deliver	Whole of club	Have information ready prior to nomination/ elections	Successfully have a diverse committee Seek feedback on what did/ didn't work
